## **Ealing School Streets**

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have some very exciting news! The Perivale School Street Scheme will launch on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2020. This is a short closure of the streets around the school at the start and end of the school day during term time. This will make the streets a safer, more welcoming environment for all who use it while maintaining access for residents, blue badge holders, pedestrians and cyclists.

The benefits of such a scheme are:

- Significantly less traffic outside the school making it safer for families travelling to and from school
- Easier/safer to cross the roads
- Walking and cycling will become more appealing
- Improved air quality outside the school
- Quieter and calmer

Who will have access to drive into the street?

- Permit holders only
- Residents and some blue badge holders will have access to the closed road during the timed closure
- No parents or carers will be allowed to drive down the road unless they are permit holders.
- Vehicles without a permit entering the scheme during operational hours will be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice

What will the School Street look like?

- At the entry points, there will be signs saying the road is a Pedestrian and Cycle Zone
- Advance warning signs will be placed in the local area to notify drivers of the scheme
- Streets will become access only, with no traffic except approved permit holders
- The area will become a pedestrian and cycle zone, making it safer and more welcoming for all who use it.

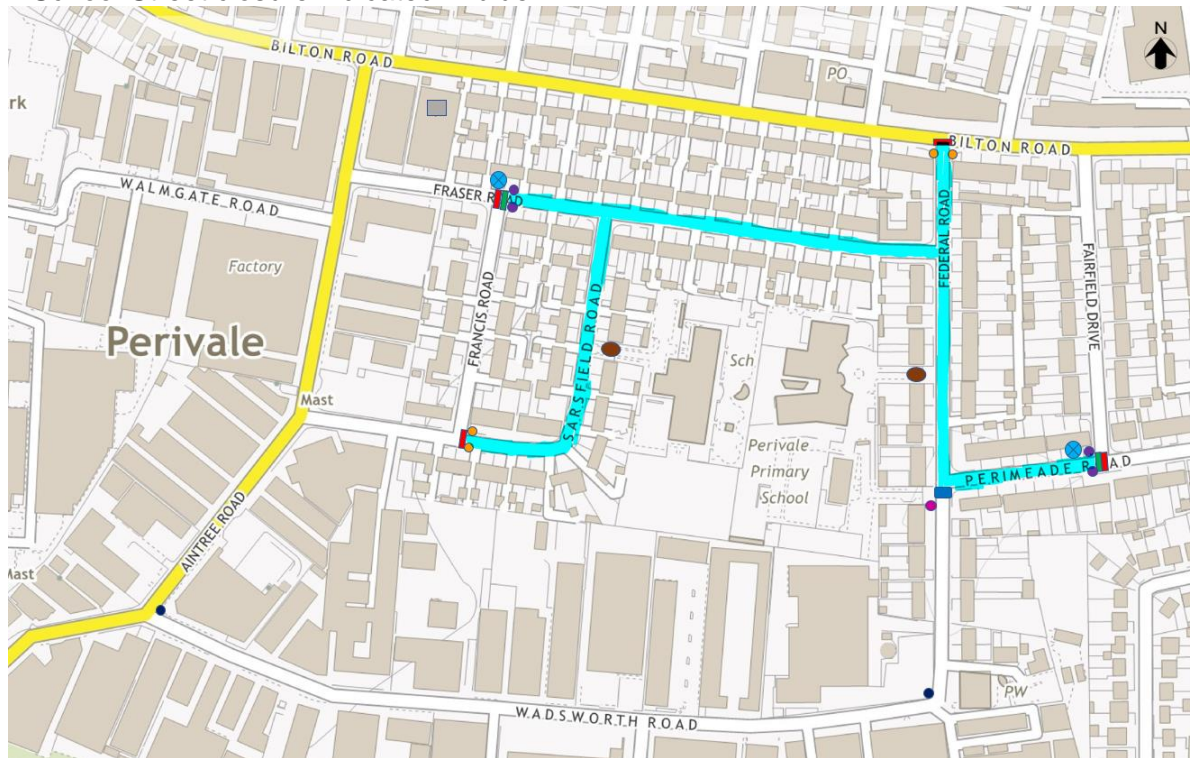


The Scheme will commence on **2<sup>nd</sup> September 2020**. **Parts of Perimeade, Federal, Fraser and Sarsfield Roads** (as marked in blue on map below) will be **closed to traffic between 8.15-9.15am and 2.45-3.45pm**, Monday to Friday during term time. Enforcement will be via ANPR camera. Parents will not be allowed to drive down the above-named roads between these hours without a permit. Driving through the scheme during operational hours will result in vehicles being issued with a Penalty Charge Notice.
