

Home Reading Books

We are delighted to start sending home reading books for children from Years 1 to 6 to practice reading at home from Friday this week. Children are expected to read with an adult for at least 10 minutes a day for all year groups. For children who are learning and consolidating their phonic knowledge we will be sending home phonetically decodable books. These books follow a specific order and so we may ask you to read a book using the online Big Cat e-reader if we do not have enough copies of the book to send home

Reading activities will be posted on the Google Classroom for your child to complete alongside any book that they read.

Books will be changed once a week. If the book is not in school on that specific day then the book will be changed the following week.

Damaged, defaced or lost books will incur a £5 replacement charge per book.

A parent workshop for KS1 parents to explain more details about reading at home will be held via zoom on Tuesday 5th October at 10:00am. A text message with the link will be sent to parents on the morning of the workshop.
