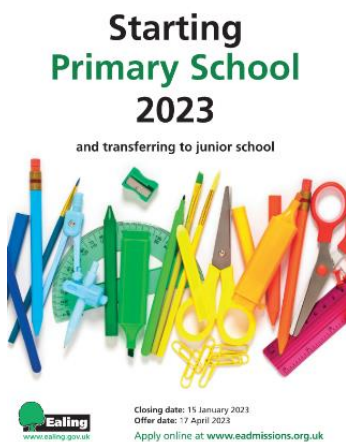
## Attendance
