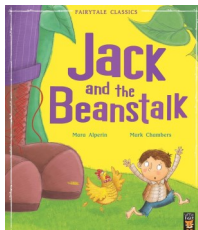
Literacy

In Literacy, we will focus on three areas: Phonics, Reading and Writing.

In Phonics, we will recap and embed all of our learning in Reception so far. We will consolidate blending, segmenting and reading tricky words.

In Reading, we will start to use some of the sounds we have learnt in Phonics and use them when reading. We will answer comprehension style questions about a range of exciting books.

In Writing, we will use 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and 'Avocado Baby' as our focus texts. We will be learning the story using a story map and then move on to writing a range of genres to support the learning. We will be writing instructions when planting a bean and expressing our ideas related to the story.

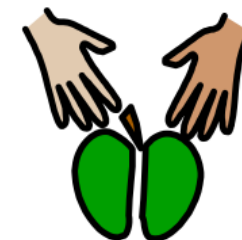


Maths

In Maths, we will practise how to double numbers, as an introduction in to even and odd numbers up to 10.

We will learn how to share and group objects and numbers, through practical activities.

We will be using positional language and directions, using and creating maps and routes.



Understanding the World

This half term, we will be growing sunflowers and planting beans.

Throughout the term, we will be looking at recycling and the importance that has on the environment.

We will be revisiting our learning on the different seasons, and identifying how we know what season it is.



Expressive Arts and Design

This half term, we will be completing art related to our growth topic.

We will be painting sunflowers, butterflies and nature themed objects.

We will use watercolours and a range of different mediums.

We will enhance our DT skills by creating split pin sunflowers.
