
Writing

This half term, Year 3 will be exploring non fiction texts, in particular non chronological 🔀 reports. Our book is called: writing Rainbow 'Earth-Shattering Events'. We be looking at their features, using the model text to create an example before using this knowledge to create their own non chronological report on something of their choi.ce.



This half term the children will continue to use VIPERS to develop their reading skills. We will be looking at nonfiction texts, based on natural disasters. The children will look at a variety of texts that focus on Earthquakes as

this is the topic we are exploring in Writing. During Reading lessons, the Non children will learn the key vocabulary and be able to comprehend scientific terms in order to understand the text they are exploring.

Science


In Science, we will be revisiting the 5 previous topics which have been covered in Year 3. The children will be learning about science and inventors linked with each of these topics.



Geography

This half term, the children will be learning about land use in our local area. They will have

a go at drawing sketch maps, they will look at symbols on maps and will discover how much of the land is used for homes, shops and parks.

D&T

This half term we will be looking at pneumatics and mechanical systems. We will investigate how air pressure is used to make things move and use this research to design,

create and evaluate our own mechanical systems.



Computing

This half term the children will be learning about creating media and desktop publishing. They will use search technologies effectively, appreciate how results are selected and ranked, and be discerning in evaluating digital content. They will select, use and combine a variety of software.

PSHE

This half term the PSHE focus will continue be relationships. Children will be exploring the relationships they have

with others as well as their selves. We will also be learning about the human body.



Home Learning

Home Learning will be set on a Friday and due in the following Wednesday. The children will be set daily reading and weekly grammar, maths and spellings.

ΡF

This term the children will be focusing on Athletics. To be able to perform the basic technique for effective running. To understand how exercise affects the body. To understand the importance of pacing and speed judgment when running a race.

RE
