Drumming workshop to celebrate the Windrush 75th Anniversary

Last Friday we had a drumming workshop to celebrate the 75th anniversary of the HMT Empire Windrush arriving in Britain on 22nd June 1948. The day celebrates the contribution and achievements of the Windrush generation and their descendants. The children had an assembly and then some had a chance to try some drumming and using the steel pans. The children wore bright colours to represent the Caribbean where the Windrush generation originated from.

Year 5 have been learning all about the Empire Windrush in writing this term. Inspired by the story of John Agard's Windrush Child, Lime and Sycamore wrote poems about the journey taken in 1948.
