

The 32.5 hour minimum expectation includes the time in each day from the official start of the school day (i.e. morning registration) to the official end of the compulsory school day (i.e. official home time). The 32.5 hour minimum includes lunch times and other breaks as well as teaching time and any enrichment activities that all pupils are expected to attend. It does not include optional before or after school provision. The total school time is 32.5 hours



School Day Structure

Our staff welcome our children into the school gates every morning, where members of the Leadership Team will be on duty outside to supervise the children and talk to parents.

Registration closes at 9:00am. Lessons begin promptly after registration and it is important that lessons are not disrupted by late arrivals. Children, who are late, miss important introductions to lessons.

Drop-off and Collection

Class Teachers will always endeavour to make themselves available for parents to speak to after school. This helps to build up a close relationship between home and school – we want to have good links with all parents.

If normal arrangements have to be altered (for example, you are delayed or another person is collecting your child), please let us know via the school office. This avoids any confusion or upset for our children.

Some of our children are allowed to walk to and from school by themselves and their parents will have signed an electronic permission form to allow this.

Travelling To and From School

Walking is definitely the best option for getting to and from school! There are many benefits: it's healthier than travelling by car, it improves the safety of pedestrians and roadusers, and it respects nearby residents and parking regulations. Alternatively, we have bike and scooter racks at school.

If you do need to travel by car, please be respectful of our residents by not blocking residential driveways or double parking We urge parents to avoid traffic congestion in the road immediately outside of our school. Please park considerately to our local residents.
