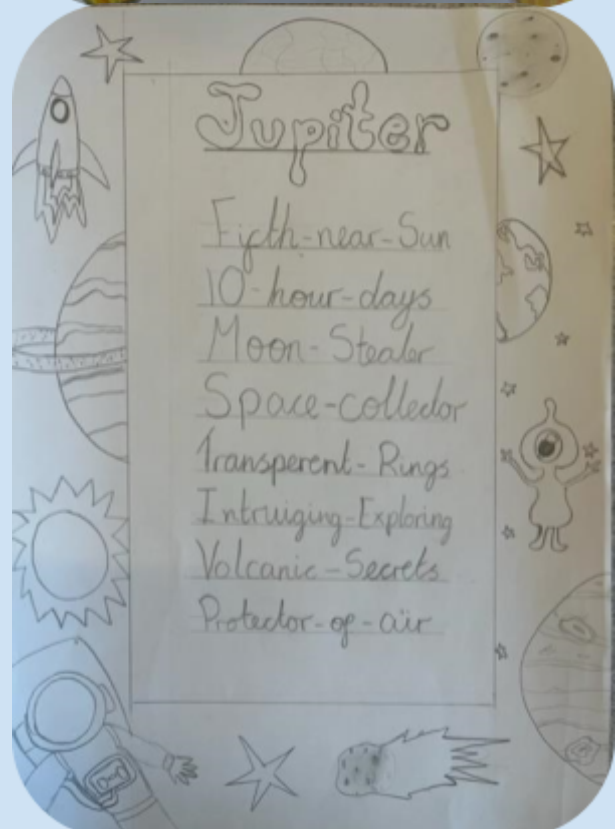
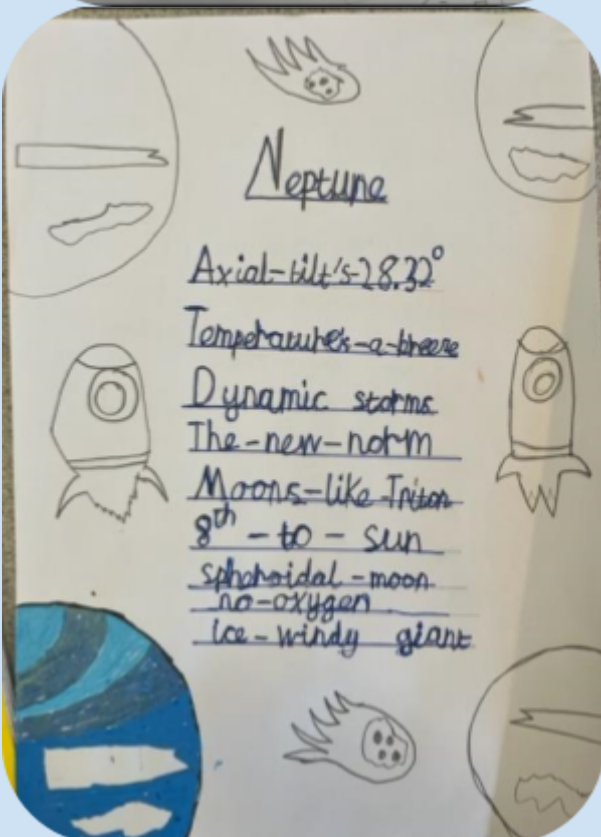
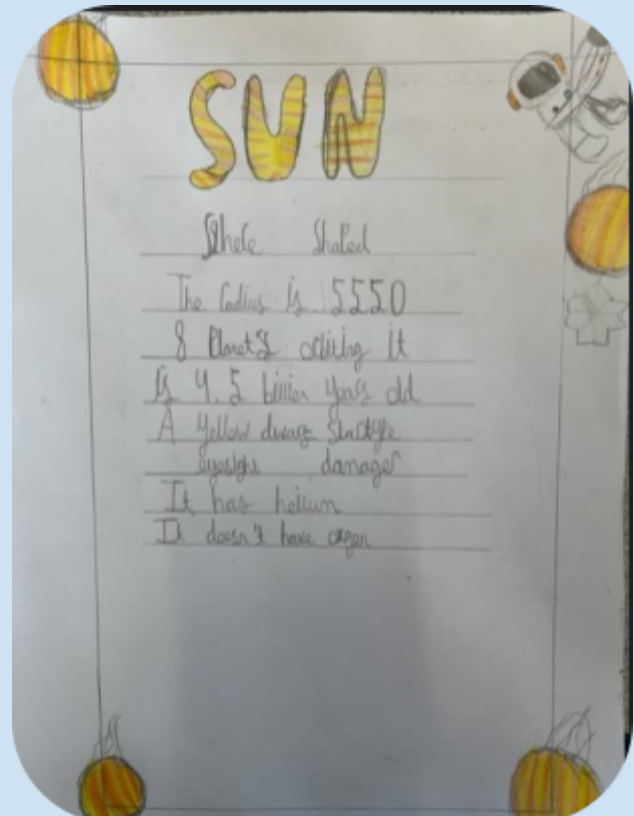
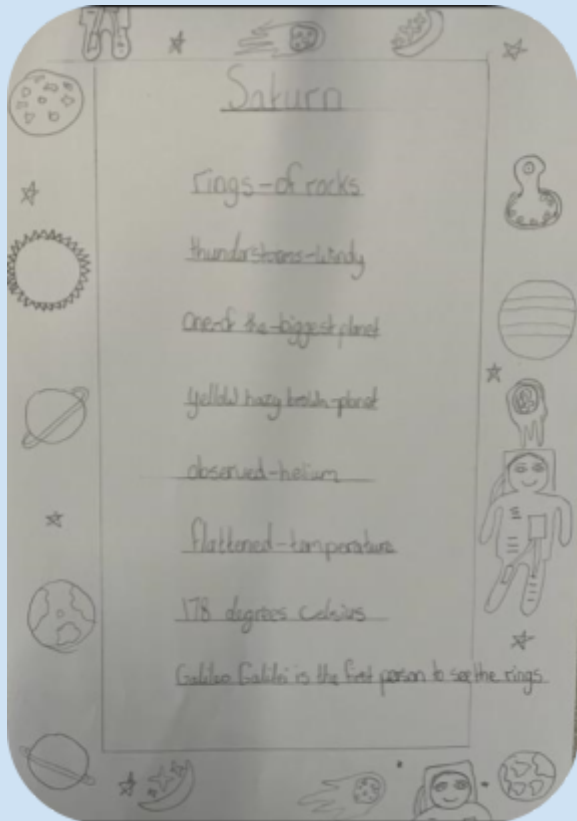
We launched a “Pat on the Back” award scheme to admire each other’s achievements and give each other a gentle pat on the back and words of encouragement.
