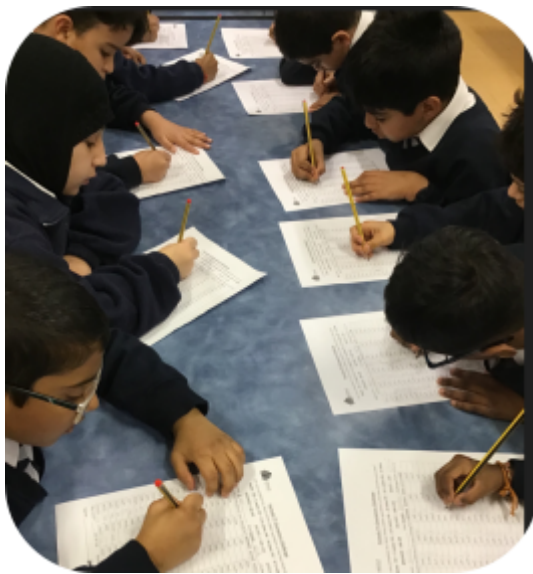

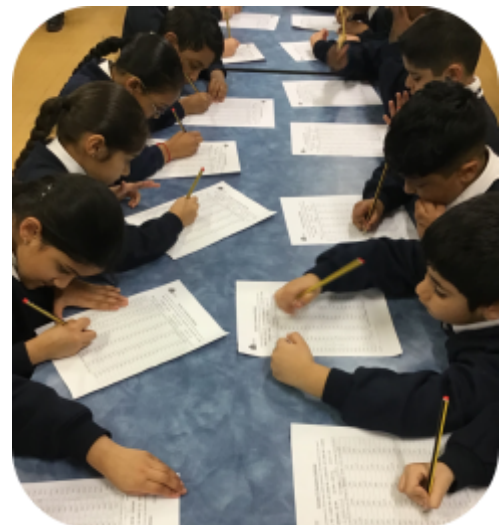
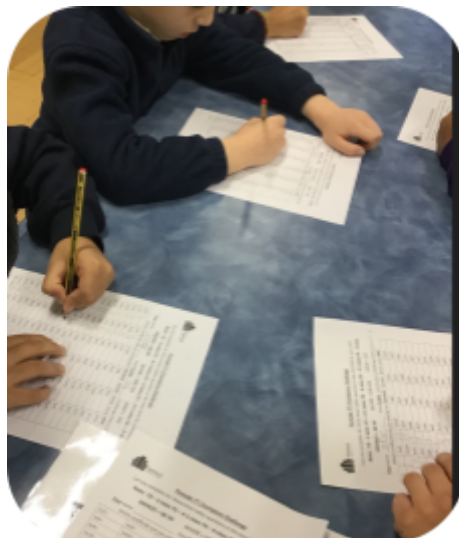


Timetable Champion Day

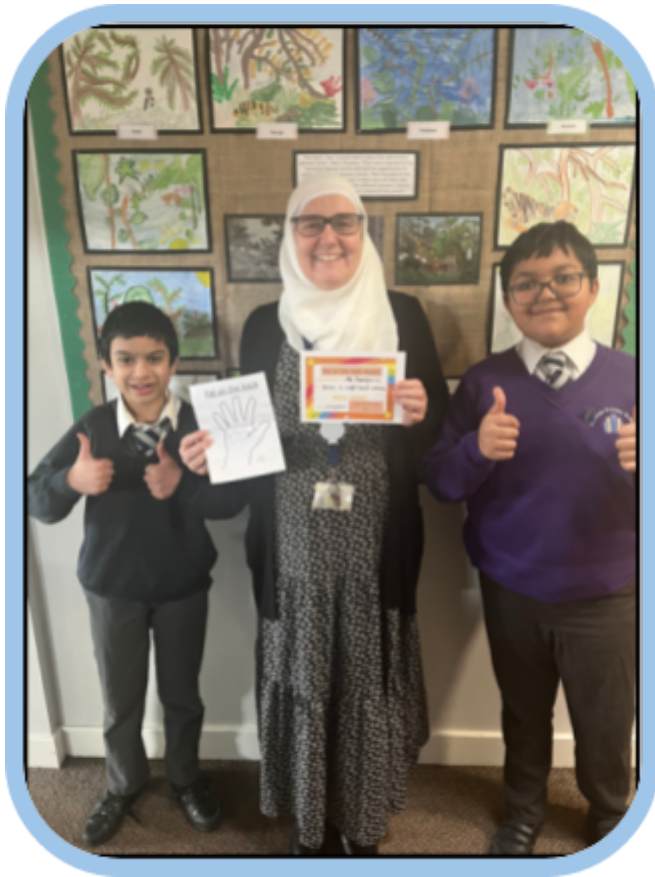
Children's Mental Health Week


