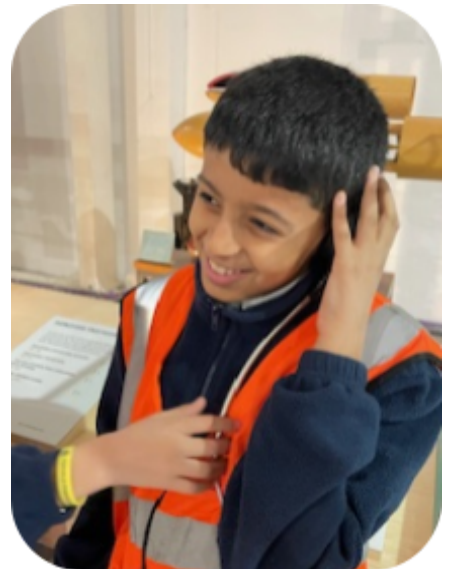

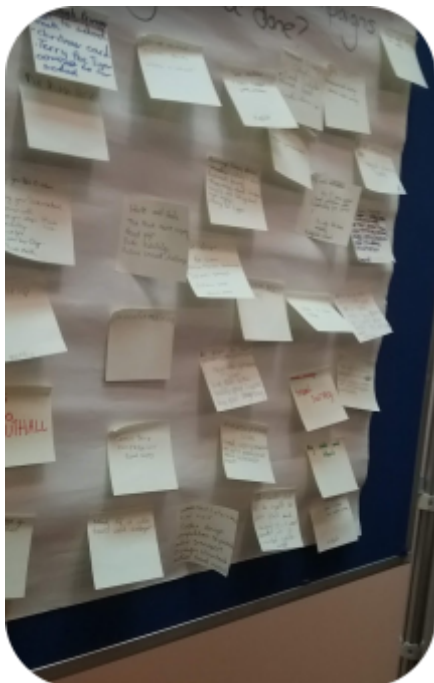
Year 6 RAF Museum visit

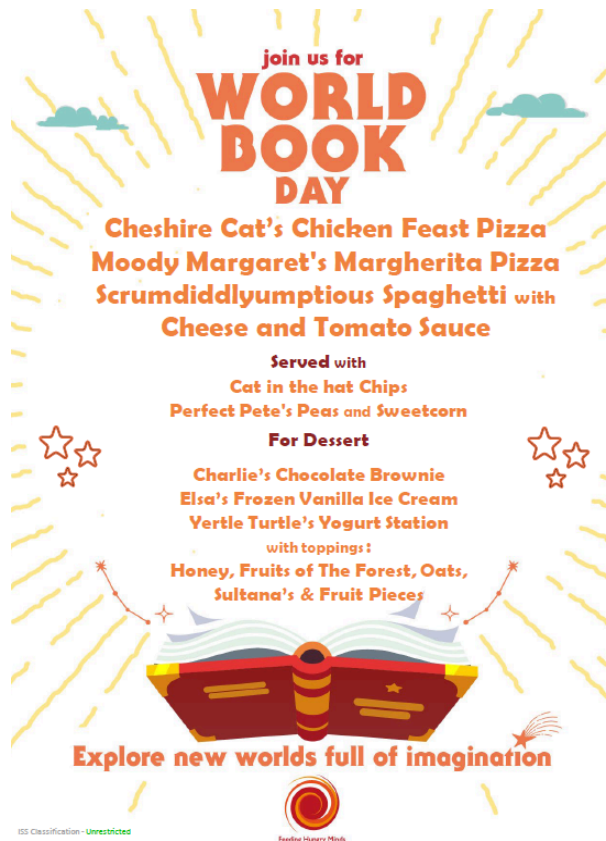
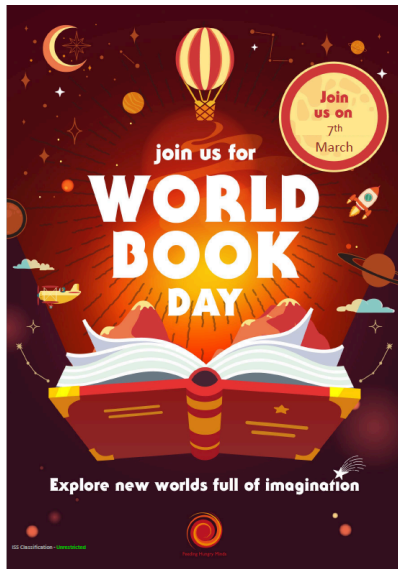
